



### The Transitus of St. Francis of Assisi

A very ancient tradition draws Franciscans worldwide on the eve of the Feast of St. Francis to celebrate his Transitus: the final stage of his journev home to God.

A Vigil Memorial Service celebrating St. Francis' " passing over" from this life to the glory of heaven will be held on Thursday 3rd Oct. at 7.00 pm in the Church.
