Hall Update- The survey results showed that 88% support granting the school exclusive use of the Hall during the renovation of the school buildings, while only 11% opposed the idea. Starting in January of next year, the school will have exclusive access to the Hall. Until then, parishioners can rent the Hall for a \$150 bond and \$50 per hour, while non-parishioners will be charged \$60 per hour. 
